



# London Goodenough Association of Canada 2021-2022 Scholarship Application Form

This scholarship is available to Canadian citizens or permanent residents of Canada. Applicants must be full-time students enrolling in or currently enrolled in an accredited graduate program in London, UK, or undertaking thesis research (Masters or Doctoral) in London while enrolled in a graduate program of study elsewhere.

Scholarships are paid in the form a credit to a student's residence account while living in Goodenough College. Winners are required to reside at the College for a full UK academic year (September – June) although up to two awards for a minimum of six months residency (normally starting in September) to support thesis research will be considered. Scholarships are nonrenewable. While scholarship winners are guaranteed single room accommodation at Goodenough College only, larger rooms or flats may be requested and provided, subject to availability.

Please send all completed Applicant Materials comprised of: this signed Application Form; the Applicant Statement of Purpose; a Thesis or Research statement (if applicable); any relevant supporting material. In addition, all applicants must arrange for the delivery of original copies of supporting materials to be delivered to the address below. Supporting Materials include: original transcripts from ALL post-secondary institutions attended (including CEGEPS, colleges, universities, exchange study institutions, etc.); three (3) confidential letters of reference, normally from academic or professional referees with direct knowledge of your academic qualifications for your proposed course of study.

2. Academic transcripts must be received in envelopes that have been sealed and endorsed by the issuing institution to authenticate their official status. It is preferred, though not required, that transcripts be mailed directly to the London Goodenough Association of Canada (LGAC) by the issuing institution.
3. All documents and any other supporting materials submitted to the LGAC in support of an application for a scholarship become the property of the LGAC and will not be returned to the applicant.
4. For the purpose of the **LGAC / Molson Foundation Scholarship for Francophone Canadians** award designation, 'francophone' means "French is spoken in the home and the candidate studied primarily in the French language". Supporting evidence may be requested by the LGAC.
5. Scholarship winners are required to report any other awards they receive. Additional awards or income may reduce the funding level of an LGAC Scholarship.
